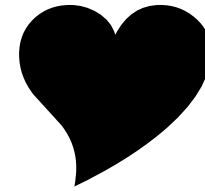




How to make Love!



The Orphanage guide to making
and creating heart badges

Ingredients – what you will need



- Assorted pieces of fabric including:
 - Felt or very stiff fabric for the internal badge strength
 - Colourful light fabrics for front and back
 - Colourful fabrics (can be as thick as the felt) for the heart symbol
- Small sharp needle
- Variety of different coloured threads
- Good quality very sharp small and large sewing scissors (do not use to cut anything except fabric/thread!)
- Safety pin (30-40mm length max)

Ingredients – what they look like...



A. Heart

B. Heart circle

C. Front

E. Internal

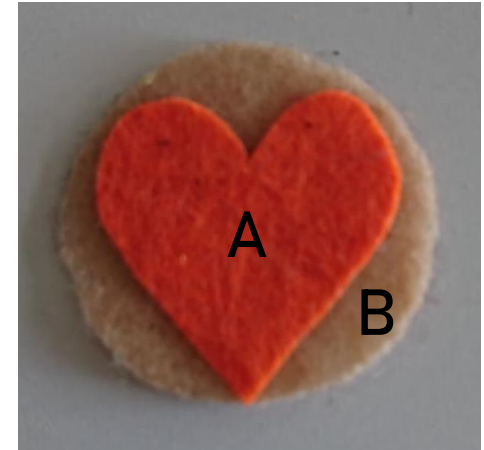
D. Backing (with safety pin)



Assembling Love together...

- Step 1
 - Cut-out templates and place on fabric pieces, draw around template and cut
 - Sew together Heart (A) and Heart Circle (B) pieces together using needle and thread

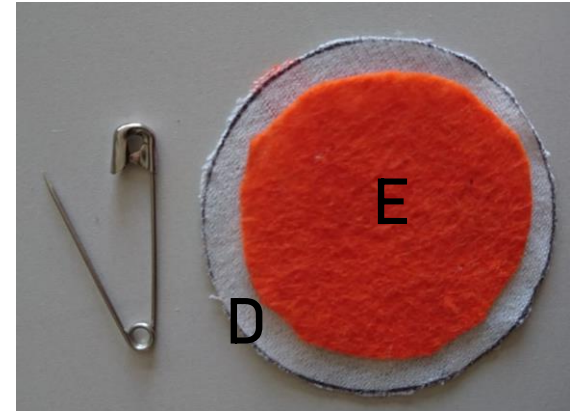
- Step 2
 - Sew Heart on the circle from Step 1 (A+B) to the front badge piece (C)



Illustrated without thread sewing.

Assembling Love together...

- Step 3
 - Sew together the safety pin through the back piece (D) and internal piece (E)



- Step 4
 - Sew together the two halves from Step 2 and Step 3 with long stitches

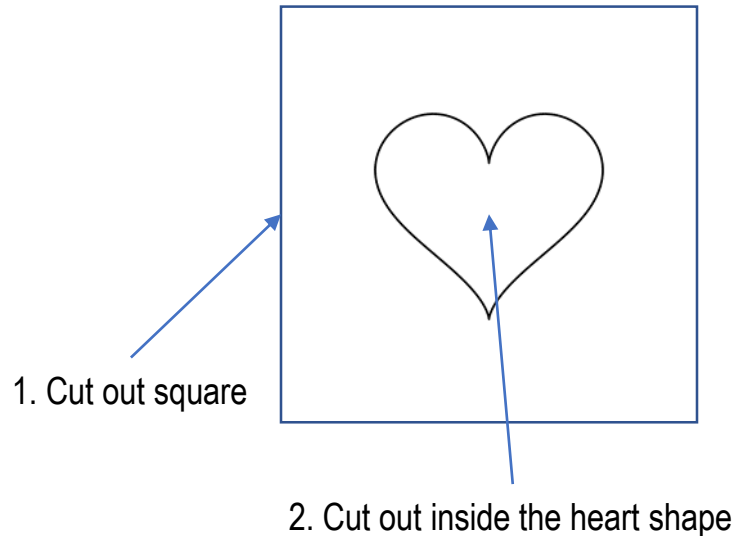
